No:F.10(18)/Fin(T&E)/2009-10/ – In exercise of the powers conferred by section 58 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Punjab Act 1 of 1914) as extended to the National Capital Territory of Delhi, the Lieutenant Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Delhi Liquor Licence Rules, 1976 and since it is considered that they should be brought into force at once, he has further directed that these rules shall come into force with immediate effect without previous publication, namely:-

Lodging House Licence from DCP(L), Delhi police; 2. Lodging House Licence from MCD/NDMC; 3. No objection Certificate from the Tourism Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi (in case of Guest Houses only)"
Amendment of rule 34.	5.		In the principal Rules, in rule 34: - (a) in sub-rule (5), in the heading, after the word "Hotel", the words "and guest house" shall be inserted; (b) in sub-rule (5), after clause (c), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely: - "Provided that in case of guest house, the licensee shall possess the no objection from the Tourism Department of this Government."
