Minutes of meeting held in the chamber of Collector (Excise) on 19/01/2010 at 3.00 P.M. regarding affixation of Security Holograms on IMFL.

A meeting of all the Bond Inspectors on the above cited subject was convened which was chaired by Collector (Excise). Following officers were present:

Collector (Excise) at the outset informed that since the initiation of process of affixation of holograms some problems are being reported from various stakeholders which are being addressed appropriately.


It was directed that each and every step has been minutely explained in various office orders which have been issued earlier in this regard. further it was directed that due diligence be observed in implementation of orders and following points be strictly followed:

- 1) All the Transport Permits being issued should invariably bear the specific detail of number of holograms contained in the carton being supplied through that particular Transport Permit.
- 2) If the above detail is too voluminous the same may be mentioned in a separate sheet duly signed and stamped by Bond Inspectors, attached with the T.P. This sheet should bear the name of the Vend / HRC, T.P. Number and date item description.

- 3) Bond Inspectors should discuss with respective Licensees and sort out the problem being faced with regard to improper sequencing of holograms on stock being received from distilleries
- 4) Bond Inspectors to ensure that the stock received without holograms (before the prescribed date i.e. 05/01/2010) should be dispatched first to the vends so that the stock without holograms is exhausted as early as possible.
- 5) It is advised that arrangements should be made at distilleries whereby the holograms are affixed according to a particular sequence which would make the accounting easy.
- 6) The Transport Permit is being issued with increased validity of two days i.e. for four & five days for IMFL and Beer respectively as a temporary measure which would be reviewed once the initial hiccups are settled.
- 7) Bonds Inspectors to ensure that no further re-validation of T.P. is sought since the validity is already increased to four and five days as the case may be.
- 8) All the Bond Inspectors should send daily report of stock received with holograms, this should be sent by e-mail at [supermit2010@gmail.com](mailto:supermit2010@gmail.com) every day before 11.00 A.M.

It was emphasized by the Collector (Excise) that the orders / directions should be strictly adhered to and any dereliction shall be viewed seriously.


