CIRCULAR

Sub: Organisation of Delhi State Games for all Disabilities w.e.f. 14th Feb. 2011 to 17th Feb. 2011.

Reference is invited towards this office earlier circular No. DE. 41/6/ Sports/2011/13055-13105 dated 19.1.2011 whereby the District Games for all Disabilities have been organised in respect of District North-West, South-West and South.

Now "Special Olympics Bharat" (SOB) is organizing Delhi State Games for all disabilities w.e.f. 14th Feb. 2011 to 17th Feb. 2011 at Thyagraj Stadium.

SOB has informed that participation for the State Games will be restricted to a total of 300 athletes. For this, 100 athletes are required to take part from each of the three above named Districts. Similarly to conduct the State Games, there is a requirement of 10 volunteer teachers from each District who completed the teachers orientation programme for two days prior to the conduct of the district Games. The athletes will be the ones who have won Gold or a Silver medal. The names of these coaches and teachers are being forwarded telephonically bt SOB to the respective Govt. Schools/teachers.

All the Heads of concerned schools are requested to bring the contents of this circular into the knowledge of concerned athletes and teachers and allow them for the State Games.

Each District may bring their District flag and a placard for the Opening Ceremony which will be conducted at 1100 hours on the 14th Feb. 2011 at Thyagraj Stadium. For the North West Districts A & B, a suitable bus has been planned by SOB to depart from Chhatrasal Stadium at 0900 hours on both the days, which will commute the athletes and the teacher desirous of availing the facility to participate for the event at Theygraj Stadium to and fro. The timings for the event will be from 1000 hours to 1600 hours. Refreshments and T- Shirts will be provided by Special Olympics Bharat.

All the participating teachers will be treated "on duty" during the period of competition.
