RULES FOR RAJIV GANDHI STATE SPORTS AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE IN SPORTS & GAMES

1. These rules may be called "Rules for Rajiv Gandhi State Sports Awards" for outstanding performance in Sports & Games.
2. The object of these Awards is to encourage the development of games and sports in the NCT of Delhi.
3. Entries will be invited every year from the Govt. of India /IOA recognized National Sports Federations/State Associations as well as from individual by 30<sup>th</sup> June for Awards in the respective sports.

In addition, nominations will also be invited from Sports Control / Promotion Boards of various Government Organization such as the All Indian Police Sports Control Board, Army Sports Control Board, Railway Sports Promotion Board, Services Sports Control Board, Indian Navy Sports Control Board and Air Force Sports Control Board etc.

4. Maximum six awards will be given in a particular year. Ordinarily, not more than one award will be given in one sports in a particular year subject to deserving persons being available.

However, keeping in view the performance of Indian Sportspersons in the Commonwealth, Asian Games and Olympic Games during a particular year Government may announce suitably increasing the number of awards for the succeeding year in respect of these awards

5. The awards will be made in respect of the Calendar year for which the applications are invited. Entries will be invited in a prescribed proforma giving the past performance of the persons in the National & International contest for three years generally and for the year of the Awards in particular.
6. The candidate must be a bonafide resident of Delhi continuously for the last five years.
7. A Special Committee will be set up to scrutinize all the entries received and make its recommendations to the Government of Delhi. The Committee will determine its own work procedure.
8. Notwithstanding the entries received from the recommending body, the Government of NCT of Delhi reserves the right to make nominations of sports persons in deserving cases for Rajiv Gandhi Sports Awards subject to fulfilment of these guidelines.
9. The recommending body would be free to recommend more than one name and upto 3 names in a particular event to the Govt. of Delhi.

10. To be eligible for the Rajiv Gandhi Sports Awards, a sports person should have had not only good performance consistently for the previous three years at the National/ International level with the excellence for the year for which the Awards is recommended but also should have shown qualities of leadership, sportsmanship and a sense of discipline. However, sportsperson found positive for use of prohibited /banned drugs shall not be considered for the awards. Govt. of Delhi will also consider giving Awards to such sports persons who have contributed their life to the sports and sports promotion.
11. The Government will only consider conferring Rajiv Gandhi State Sports Awards to the disciplines falling under following categories:
  - (i) Olympic Games / Asian Games / Commonwealth Games / World Cup/ World Championship disciplines and Cricket or any equivalent recognized international tournament.
  - (ii) Indigenous Games.
  - (iii) Physically Challenged / Intellectual disabled/ Deaf and Dumb sportspersons.
12. The decision of the Government of Delhi in respect of the Awards will be final.
13. The Rajiv Gandhi Sports Award will consist of a Citation, a Befitting Memento and Cash Award of Rs. 2.00 lakhs. These awards may be presented to the winners at a function to be held on 20<sup>th</sup> August at a place to be determined by the Govt. of Delhi.
14. Canvassing in any form in respect of any entry will render that entry liable to disqualification.
15. No Award will be made for a second time to the same person.
16. The Award may be given posthumously if such an occasion arises.
17. The Govt. of Delhi may cancel or annul the Award to any person, thereupon the recipient shall be required to surrender the Citation and the Memento but it shall be competent for the Govt. of Delhi to restore the Award once the cancellation and annulment has been withdrawn.
18. The decision of the Govt. of Delhi in respect of interpretation of these rules shall be final and no appeal shall lie against them
19. A person who is recommended for the Rajiv Gandhi Sports Awards shall be deemed to have accepted these Rules.
