## CIRCULAR

The Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has introduced a 'Scheme of Sports & Games for the Disabled' with an objective to broad-base participative sports among the disabled.

Further, the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has designated "Special Olympics Bharat" as the Nodal Agency for the purpose of Master Trainers' training; training of community coaches and conduct of sports competitions at district and state / UT level for the Persons with disabilities for the year 2011-12.

Accordingly, Special Olympics Bharat has decided to organize district level sports competitions in respect of districts North and Central in the following disciplines:

- Football
- Athletics
- Badminton
- Bocce
- · Table-Tennis
- Kho-Kho

The students with any kind of disability can participate in these games. The maximum ceiling of participants will be 225 in each district in the sub-junior, junior and Sr. category in the following manner:

Sl. No.	Category	Age permissible
1.	Sub Junior	8-15 years
2.	Junior	16-21 years
3.	Senior	21 years and above

The schedule of district level training of coaches and organization of games is as follows:

#### **District Central:**

- Training for 50 coaches (PETs) will be undertaken at Thyagraj Stadium (Near Safdarjung Bus Terminal) from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2011
- Organization and conduct of games of Football, Athletics, Bocce, Table-Tennis Badminton and Kho Kho games will take place at Thyagraj Stadium on 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> Sept 2011. Athletes are required to report at 9:00 am and the games will be concluded by 4p.m. Opening Ceremony will take place at 09:30 am on 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept and Closing Ceremony with prize distribution between 2 pm to 4 pm on 24<sup>th</sup> Sept.

## District North:

- Training for 50 coaches (PETs) will be undertaken at Chhatrasal Stadium from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2011.
- Organization and conduct of games of Football, Athletics, Bocce, Table-Tennis and Kho Kho games will take place at Chhatrasal Stadium on 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> November 2011. Badminton will take place at Ludlow Castle Sports Complex Civil Lines on 3<sup>th</sup> and 4th November 2011. Athletes are required to report at 9:00 am and the games will be concluded by 4pm. Opening Ceremony will take place at 09:30 am on 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov and Closing Ceremony with prize distribution between 2pm to 4pm on 4<sup>th</sup> Nov.

The Deputy Directors of Education of the concerned districts are requested to bring the contents of training of coaches and competitions into the knowledge of all the Heads of schools of their districts so that the students with any kind of disability may participate in these games. The Principals may send their entries directly to "Special Olympics Bharat-Delhi". The escorts should carry hard copy to the venue for registrations. The Principals are requested to ensure that the entries are forwarded game wise with number of athletes in each game, name, age and type of disability to be included. Lists for male and female athletes is to be forwarded separately. SOB-Delhi contact details are as under:

The Deputy Directors of Education of the concerned districts are requested to nominate Physical Education Teachers from their districts to receive training and conduct competitions on above days in the following manner:

The PET's to be informed about nature of activities i.e theory classes will be conducted for the full first day which includes knowledge of Special Olympics and disabilities and rules governing all disability games.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> day, practical training will be given in the field to understand the applicability of the rules. PET's should be physically fit to undertake the field training.

The entire expenditure towards organizational expenses, officiating charges, charges for opening / closing ceremonies, TA for officials, shamiana, refreshment charges, medals, certificates, charges for sports equipments & any other miscellaneous expenses will be borne by the "Special Olympics Bharat".

All the participating PETs will be treated "On Duty" during the period of training and competitions. The officials who have undergone LNUPE course at Gwalior in Aug 2011 (List attached) are to function as Resource Persons during the duration of District Games, Training and Competitions.
