This is to thank you for nominating some of your officers / doctors to the one year PG Diploma Course in Disaster Preparedness & Rehabilitation (part time programme) to the earlier batches. This year the course for the 6th batch (2011-2012) will be started from 12th September 2011.

India is a disaster prone country and as auxiliary to the Government, Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) assists the Government in relief and rehabilitation activities following disasters. Red Cross has the mandate and rich experience of organizing relief operations in times of disaster. It has trained members who initiate action and get involved in rapid response in situations of calamity. However, there is a massive need to enlarge this cadre base of trained personnel in this field.

As a leading institution in the field, IRCS launched a one year part time PG Diploma Course in Disaster Preparedness and Rehabilitation in 2006. The course is affiliated to the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi. This provides a unique opportunity to working professionals and others to acquire necessary capabilities to provide leadership in the field in times of need. This part time course focuses on the development of skills and abilities in the field of disaster that matches the best practices available in this discipline today. Emphasis of the course has been to train professionals to improve the emergency response mechanism of the local bodies as far as preparedness, mitigation, relief and rehabilitation is concerned. The course is being conducted at the Disaster Management Centre, IRCS (NHQ), 1-Red Cross Road, New Delhi-110001. The classes are being held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 6.30 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 10.00 am to 2.00 p.m.
