I am directed to say that the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dt.28.4.2009 in I.A. No.244 of 2009 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.1022/1989, All India Judges Association & Ors. Vs UOI & Ors., had, inter-alia, appointed a one member Committee with Shri Justice E. Padmanabhan, retired High Court Judge directing that the said Committee may make suitable recommendations having regard to the recommendations already made by the Justice Shetty Commission in respect of pay scales and allowances and other perquisites of the judicial officers of the States. The Committee submitted its report before the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 17.07.2009.

2. The Central Government have given careful consideration to the recommendations of Justice E. Padmanabhan Committee in respect of the pay scales in order to give effect in so far as they relate to the judicial officers of the Union Territories and have decided to implement the same. Sanction of the competent authority is hereby conveyed to the revised pay scales of the judicial officers working in various Union Territories which are as follows:-

3. The pay scales of Judicial Officers in the Union Territories may be revised with effect from 1st January, 2006. The Judicial Officers may be paid 60% of the arrears of pay and allowances in cash and 40% deposited in their Provident Fund accounts.

4. The expenditure involved shall be met out of Budget provisions of the concerned Union Territories.

5. This issues with the concurrence of D/o Expenditure, M/o Finance vide IC U.O. No.10/1/2010-IC dated 23.2.2010 & U.O. No.7/24/4/2009-IC dated 26.07.2011.


