No.244 of 2009 in WriteRetition (Civil) No.1022/1989 (All India and gest Association & Ors. Vs UOI & Ors., had, inter-alia, appointed a one member Committee with Shri Justice E. Padmanabhan, retired High Court Judge directing that the said Committee may make suitable recommendations having regard to the recommendations already made by the Justice Shetty Commission in respect of pay scales and allowances and other perquisites of the judicial officers of the States. The Committee submitted its report before the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 17.07.2009. The Central Government have given careful consideration to the recommendations of Justice E. Padmanabhan Committee in respect of the pay scales in order to give effect in so far as they relate to the judicial officers of the Union Territories and have decided to implement the same.
