CIRCULAR

The Excise Year 2010-11 is ending on 31st March 2011. As per Rule 41 of The Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 all applications for renewal of Licence shall be received in the office of the Deputy Commissioner (Excise) before the end of February each year along with the Licence Fee, payable for the renewal of the Licence. In case of delay, the Deputy Commissioner may admit such application before the expiry of the Licence provided that there are good and sufficient reasons for the delay on payment of additional fee of twenty five percent of the prescribed Licence Fee.

PROVIDED that the application for renewal of Licence may be admitted after the expiry of the Licence, if there are good and sufficient reasons for the delay on payment of double the amount of Licence fee payable, and the Licence may be renewed with the approval of the Excise Commissioner.

In view of above, all the existing L-12 (formerly L-53) Licence holders are directed to submit their requests for renewal of their Licence for the year 2011-12 before 28.02.2011. The following documents are required to be submitted along with application for the renewal of L-12 Licence; -

1. Treasury Receipt (TR) of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two lakhs only) towards Licence Fee in the Excise Head 0039, Sub Head 01, Branch Code 'L-12' with their respective Payee Codes.
2. No Dues Certificate, in original, stating that the applicant is not a defaulter in respect of Value Added Tax (VAT) from the Trade and Taxes Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
3. Copy of Ownership/Lease Agreement valid at least up to 31.03.2012 duly attested.
4. Quarterly Sales Figure separately for Beer and other Departmental Store items during the period 01.04.2010 to 31.01.2011.
5. Original L-12 License.
6. An Affidavit stating that: -
 - (i) The Licensee is in lawful physical possession of the premises in respect of which he was granted Licence.
 - (ii) The Licensee is not ineligible inter-alia under the provision of Section 13 of The Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and The Delhi Excise Rules, 2010.
7. The Licensee should ensure that the licensed premises shall be duly insured against fire and natural hazards.
8. The capacity of Refrigerator for storage of Beer should not be more than 300 liters.
9. The Licensee must ensure that bar coding system has been installed and is operational.
