CIRCULAR

Sub:- Amendment in the Terms & Conditions of various licences.

While reviewing security measures, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor has decided that it be made mandatory for all liquor retail outlets including Government Corporation's outlets to install CCTV cameras outside their vends with 30 days recording facility. Further, the retailer's profit margin on sale of liquor is being revised w.e.f. 1st July, 2011 to enable the retail trade operators to carry out appropriate investment and up-gradation of their vends in the interest of the consumers.

Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government that the retail liquor vends for consumption 'off' the premises shall observe the following additional terms and conditions

(i) The holders of L-6, L-7, L-8, L-9, L-10 and L-12 licences shall install CCTV cameras with a minimum coverage of 50 meters in and around the retail vend and archival period of 30 days coverage for close monitoring of the activities around the liquor shops so as to assist regarding maintenance of law and order and public safety around these premises.

(ii) The holders of L-6, L-7, L-8, L-9, L-10 and L-12 licences shall carry out up-gradation of facilities which include renovation and re-furbishing of their outlets so as to make these clean and customer friendly.

(iii) The holders of L-6, L-7, L-8, L-9, L-10 and L-12 licences shall engage adequate man power including managerial level personnel for transacting business as per the terms and conditions.

The respective licence holders are required to follow the above additional terms & conditions in addition to the existing terms & conditions and guidelines under which they have been granted the respective licences.

A compliance report from all concerned regarding installation of CCTV Cameras should reach the undersigned within a month from the date of issue of this circular. Failure to adhere to all the terms & conditions will invite initiation of cancellation proceedings of the respective licences.
