Kind attention of all L-16/ L-17/ L-18/ L-19 licensees is invited to section 23 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 as reproduced below: -

"23. Prohibition of sale to certain persons." No person or licensed vendor or his employee or agent shall sell or deliver any liquor to any person apparently under the age of twenty five years, whether for consumption by self or others."

The sale to minor has been defined as a major offence under the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and an FIR shall be lodged against the licensee for violation of above section. Accordingly, all licensees are directed to ensure that no person below the age of 25 years is served liquor within the licensed premises. Non compliance will be viewed seriously and action for imposition of penalty under section 42 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 will be initiated.
