CIRCULAR

Following terms and conditions are framed within the ambit of section 20 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 for allowing the transfer of licence in the case of restaurant (L-17/ L-17F, L-18/ L-18F, L-19/ L-19F): -

- Proceedings of any kind under the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and rules framed thereunder or under the erstwhile Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and rules framed thereunder should not be pending against the licensee before any such approval is allowed.
- The transferee will run the restaurant/ bar in the same premises and will submit the 2: lease of the premises and insurance in his name within a period of 03 months.
- Prior approval of Licensing Authority should be sought within the purview of section 3. 20 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009.
- An affidavit will be attached along with the application for obtaining permission for 4. transfer of licence in the prescribed format. (Annexure 'A')
- Licensing Authority may permit the transfer of licence subject to payment of 25% of 5. annual licence fee for the restaurant in question.
- In case prior approval of Licensing Authority has not been sought but transferee has been able to prove that the mistake committed has been bonafide and licensing 6. authority on being satisfied may permit such transfer of licence subject to meeting of all other terms & conditions as specified above on payment of 35% of licence fee (25% of transfer fee and 10% on account of penalty for not obtaining prior approval). The decision of Licensing Authority regarding bonafides will be final.
- No refund for licence fee will be allowed to the transferor licensee for any unexpired 7. period of financial year.

- Transferee will submit all licenses/ NOCs from link departments viz. Health & Trade Licence, Eating House Licence, NOC from DFS and Approval of DOT along with PAN Card and DVAT registration certificate in the name of transferee and comply with any other condition imposed by D.C. (Excise) within a period of three-months or the validity of the licence, whichever is earlier.
- Permission for transfer on compliance of above terms and conditions will be allowed only if transfer has happened after coming into force of Delhi Excise Act, 2009 i.e. after 04.10.2010. The cases of transfer prior to 4.10.2010 will be examined as per appropriate provisions of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and rules framed thereunder.
