CIRCULAR

The Directorate of Training is entrusted with the basic responsibility of conducting training programmes for various levels of officials/officers in various areas of administration. The Directorate has identified subjects needing awareness about important social, economic, administrative and various other topics. A One day training course on "General Awareness about Rights of Children" is an important course in the list. The Course shall be held on 24.06.2011.

IMPORTANCE OF THE COURSE:

Children have the same general human rights as adults. But children are vulnerable and it is this vulnerability which calls for special care and protection. In 1992, India ratified the United Nations Convention on Rights of the Child. The Charter of Child Rights (CRC) is built on the principle that "All children are born with fundamental freedoms and all human beings have some inherent rights". There is need for general awareness about the rights of children.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES OF THE COURSE:

The Course has been designed to benefit those who are working in the Government, its local/autonomous bodies, public sector undertakings and entrusted with the responsibilities of implementation of various schemes for the children in area of health, education, nutrition and protection. The course may also be useful in context of responsibilities of parenting. It would also be beneficial to members of RWAs who play a crucial role in sensitizing people. Training Module is enclosed.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE:

At the end of the Course the participants will be able to:

1. Explain the status of children in India
2. List various Constitutional Provisions regarding Children
3. List various rights of the children

CONTENTS OF THE COURSE:

1. An overview of status of children in India
2. UN Convention, Constitutional provisions and legislations
3. Rights of the Child - The National Policy and Charter for Children
4. Responsibilities of Parents, Guardians and the State

METHODOLOGY OF THE COURSE:

The Course would be conducted by experts and those associated with implementation of child rights. While lecture method would be generally followed, discussions may also be included in some sessions. The Course would be interactive and participants encouraged raising questions and getting the doubts cleared.

NOMINATIONS FOR THE COURSE:

1. The Course envisages class strength of 40 participants.
2. Nominations shall be accepted on first-come-first-serve basis.
3. Nomination letter along with bio-data of the participants in the format prescribed (enclosed) may be sent by 17.06.2011.
4. Nominations received after 17.06.2011 may not be entertained.
5. Outstation participants are requested to proceed for training only after receipt of confirmation of acceptance of nomination.
