OFFICE ORDER

During the meeting convened by Addl. Secretary (Home) on 16.04.2012, on fire safety in schools, a point was raised by DSIIDC regarding objection of inspecting officers for dead end travel as prescribed in National Building Code of India-2005, Part 4. In this regard it is clarified that in all school buildings that are less than 09 meters in height and covered under the Education Department circular No. 3298-3398 dated 01.03.2011, the dead end travel restriction may not be insisted upon hereafter and compliance to norms as per circular be only enforced. All the cases rejected on this ground shall be reviewed and disposed off within a fortnight.

Further, it was also brought to the notice that inspecting officers are not issuing shortcomings after the inspections. Accordingly all the shortcomings, noticed during the inspection, shall be communicated to the Principals at the site.
