CIRCULAR

The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act.2009 came into force w.e.f. 1st April.2010. As per provision of Section 19 of the Act, every recognized school has to fulfill Norms and Standards specified in the schedule of the Act. The minimum number of working days as specified in the schedule for upper primary classes is 220 in an academic year.

In order to fulfill the above Norms and Standards, it has been decided that the number of holidays/ vacations in an academic year will be reviewed on yearly basis before the commencement of next calendar year.

Accordingly, all the Heads of Govt./Govt. Aided schools are directed to observe only 7 holidays (including two restricted and five local holiday) in the calendar year 2013 in addition to gazetted holidays as notified by the Administrator, GNCT. Delhi.

All Heads of Unaided recognized schools of Delhi are directed to adhere to the provision laid down in the above mentioned schedule regarding working days in an academic year.

District DDEs and Education officer are also directed to ensure the compliance of same while approving the proposals of schools for the year 2013.
