Circular

Excise Department has introduced many reforms in the recent times for service of liquor in ticketed function being held at Farm Houses, Community Halls and Banquet Halls. The facility of obtaining P-10 (A) enables these places to serve liquor during ticketed functions. The liquor served in the function must be purchased from authorized vend of Delhi. Service of liquor from duty free shop, CSD Canteen or liquor meant for other states is completely illegal.

From 24th December 2012 onwards celebrations will start on the eve of Christmas which will be followed till new year celebrations. During this period large number of Farm Houses, Community Halls and Banquet Halls shall be organizing ticketed functions. As per the provisions of the Delhi Excise Rules, the organizer has to obtain P-10 (A) on payment of due fee (the total fee is Rs. 2 lac for the period 24th December to 1st January 2013) failing which owner of these places shall be held responsible for penal action. The Department has already lodged FIRs against organizers in many cases.
