Sub: Managerial Training Programmes for May 2013

The Directorate of Training has developed training / refresher programmes for officers under the 'Managerial Competence' category. During the Month of May 2013, four training programmes on 'Basic Managerial Competence' will be organized as detailed below:-

Basic Life Support and First Aid: A two days training programme to be held from 02.05.2013 to 03.05.2013. The chief purpose of this training is to train persons for a out of hospital situation of an adult requiring. First Aid in cases of Breathing Problems, Heart Attack, Stroke, Seizures, Allergic Reactions, Fainting, Diabetes, Bleeding one can see, Wounds, Burns & Electrical emergencies, Sprains & Broken Bones, Bites & Stings, Heat related emergencies, Cold related emergencies and Poison emergencies. Nominations to be sent latest by 23.04.2013.

- Preparation of Disaster Management Plan: A three days training programme on Basic Managerial Competence in Disaster Management Plan is to be held from 08.05.2013 to 10.05.2013. The chief purpose of this course is to improve the skill sets and knowledge of the officers involved in handling various projects for the Government by acquainting them with the various phases and aspects of managing these projects i.e. planning, implementation, monitoring, closure, inventories. During the course some case studies will also be taken up. Nominations to be sent latest by 29.04.2013.
- Public Private Partnership (Awareness Course): A one day training programme on Basic Managerial Competence in Public Private Partnership (Awareness Course) is to be held on 17.05.2013. A one-day training programme aimed at elected representatives, civil society and media, with focus on providing an overview and broad exposure to key PPP concepts. Structure in four sessions, the course is expected to particularly highlight (a) the relevance of PPPs in terms of their merits and characteristics, (b) issues related to bidding and contracting such as, for example, issues of transparency, optimal allocation of risks and safeguarding public interests, (c) experience with PPPs covering both successes and failures, and (d) role of civil society and local political leadership in critical areas such as willingnessto-pay and monitoring. Nominations to be sent latest by 08.05.2013.
- Incident Response System (IRS) in Disaster Management: A four days training programme on Basic Managerial Competence in Incident Response System (IRS) in Disaster Management is to be held from 21.05.2013 to 24.05.2013. This course is meant to give a working knowledge of the Incident Response System in Disaster Management to the participants from Emergency Response Agencies and other line departments such as Police, Medical, Fire, PWD, Irrigation & Flood Control, Municipal Corporations, Delhi Jal board as well as Revenue Department / District Disaster Management Authority. Nominations to be sent latest by 13.05.2013.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES OF THE COURSES

These courses are designed to enhance the skills set and knowledge of the participating officers and to make them familiar with the new concepts, initiatives and benchmarking of the field. Besides, it would help them in their day-to-day functioning.
