This course is meant to give a working knowledge of the Incident Response System in Disaster Management to the participants from Emergency Response Agencies and other line departments such as Police, Medical, Fire, PWD, Irrigation & Flood Control, Municipal Corporations, Delhi Jal board as well as Revenue Department / District Disaster Management Authority. Team Building and Group Dynamics: A two day training programme on Team Building and Group Dynamics is to be held from 07.08.2013 to 08.08.2013. This course is meant for middle level managers to learn how to work as a Team, and learn to manage the strength and weaknesses of team members for optimum utility in the work area. Disaster Management (General Course): A three days training programme on Basic Managerial Competence in Disaster Management is to be held from 21.08.2013 to 23.08.2013. The chief purpose of this course is to improve the skill sets and knowledge of the officers involved in handling various projects for the Government by acquainting them with the various phases and aspects of managing these projects i.e. planning, implementation, monitoring, closure, inventories. During the course some case studies will also be taken up. Nominations to be sent latest by 12.08.2013.
