Sir,

As you are aware that the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) (Union Territories) Order, 1951 (copy enclosed) contain the list of 36 Castes as Scheduled Castes (in Schedule-Part-I-Delhi). It is revealed that an amendment to the aforesaid Presidential Order has taken place vide No. 15 of 1990 (dated 3rd June, 1990) vide which the Scheduled Caste Communities which are included in the Presidential Orders and converted to Buddhist religion shall be deemed to be a member of the Scheduled Caste. A copy of relevant amendment as well as copy of letter No. 12016/28/90-SCD (R-Cell) dated 20-11-1990 downloaded from the website is enclosed.

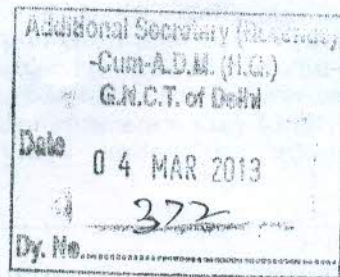

Subject : Removal of bar on the Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism from being deemed to be members of the Sch. Castes.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 31.7.1990 on the above subject, I am directed to say that with the amendment of the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Orders, 1950 by the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Orders (Amendment) Act, 1990, the Scheduled Caste communities which are included in the Presidential Orders and converted to Buddhist religion shall be deemed to be a member of the Scheduled Caste.

While issuing the Scheduled Caste certificates to these persons, the same procedure has to be followed as applicable to the members of other Scheduled Caste communities belonging to Hindu and Sikh religions.

The form of caste certificate will also remain in same as applicable to other Scheduled Caste communities (Annexure).

All the State Governments/U.T. Administrations are therefore, requested to follow the above procedure for issuing Scheduled Caste certificates to the persons professing Buddhist religion provided:

- a. the name of the community for which Scheduled Caste certificate is to be issued is included in the Presidential Order specifying the Scheduled Castes in relation to the concerned State/Union Territory;
- b. that the person and his parents actually belong to the community claimed;

- c. that the person belongs to that State and to the area within that State in respect of which the community has been scheduled, and that
- d. the person claiming to be a Scheduled Caste professes either the Hindu, the Sikh or the Buddhist religion certificate issuing authorities may kindly be instructed to make proper verification before issuing such certificates.

Director**THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ORDERS (AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1990 No. 15 of 1990**

[3rd June, 1990]

An Act further to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950 and the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) (Union Territories) Order, 1951 and to amend the Constitution (Jammu and Kashmir) Scheduled Castes Order, 1956, the Constitution (Dadra and Nagar Haveli) Scheduled Caste Order, 1962, the Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 1964 and the Constitution (Sikkim) Scheduled Castes Order, 1978.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:

1. Short title:—This Act may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Orders (Amendment) Act, 1990.
2. Amendment of the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950:— In paragraph 3 of the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950, for the words "or the Sikh C, 'the words, "the Sikh or the Buddhist" shall be substituted.
3. Amendment of the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) (Union Territories) Order, 1951:— In paragraph 3 of the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) (Union Territories) Order, 1951, for the words "or the Sikh" 'the words, "the Sikh or the Buddhist" shall be substituted.
4. Amendment of the Constitution (Jammu and Kashmir) Scheduled Castes Order, 1956:— In the proviso to paragraph 2 of the Constitution (Jammu and Kashmir) Scheduled Castes, Order 1956, for the words "or the Sikh" the words, "the Sikh or the Buddhist" shall be Substituted.
5. Amendment of the Constitution (Dadra and Nagar Haveli) Scheduled Castes Order, 1962:—In the proviso to paragraph 2 of the Constitution (Dadra and Nagar Haveli) Scheduled Castes Order, 1962, for the words "or the Sikh", the words "the Sikh or the Buddhist " shall be substituted.
6. Amendment of the Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 1964:—In the proviso to paragraph 2 of the Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 1964 for the words "or the Sikh", the words, "the Sikh or the Buddhist shall be substituted.
7. Amendment of the Constitution (Sikkim) Scheduled Castes Order, 1978:— In the proviso to paragraph 2 of the Constitution, (Sikkim) Scheduled Castes Order, 1978, for the words "or the Sikh," the words, "the Sikh or the Buddhist" shall be substituted.
