
C I R C U L A R

Whereas vide circular No.F.ADM(HQ)/2004/DENB/725-50 dated 26th February, 2006 the functioning of the Notification Branch located at Old Civil Supplies Bldg., Tis Hazari was decentralized and records of documents were transferred to each district to facilitate issue of NOC/Status Report. Of late, large number of complaints have been received by the undersigned to the effect that the notification branches which are headed by the SDMs, are not functioning properly. Unnecessary delays are taking place and lower level functionaries are conniving with touts to harass the citizens. Recently even an SDM had the gumption to put the government in an extremely embarrassing situation by issuing an NOC for a piece of land which had been notified by the Govt. for acquisition for a prestigious project and therefore, which in the first instance should have been rejected.

It is, therefore, hereby ordered that Notification Branch shall function under the direct supervision and control of the ADM of each district. ADMs shall device their own procedure to minimize complaints of harassment and corruption. As per the extant instructions of A.R. Department, in no case there shall be more than three levels of examination involved including the decision making authority, in this case the ADM. It shall also be ensured that no NOC is issued in respect of land which is already notified or is contemplated to be notified for acquisition purposes. ADM being the Land Acquisition Collectors, will be in a better position to ensure this.
