**CIRCULAR**


In response to the Motion raised by Sh. Amrish Singh Gautam, MLA, under Rule-107, in the Legislative Assembly, a committee under the Chairmanship of Sh. Charan Singh Kandra, MLA, was constituted to look into the problems being faced by Scheduled Caste members in getting Scheduled Caste certificates who have migrated in Delhi after 1951. The Committee after detailed discussions recommended that :

- I. All those migrant Scheduled Caste members whose castes are listed in the list of Scheduled Castes of National Capital Territory of Delhi and fulfill any one of the following three conditions:
  - a) The applicant should have been born in Delhi for which he/she has to produce the Birth Certificate as evidence, or
  - b) He/she should have studied in Delhi for which he/she has to produce the matriculation certificate/mark sheet as proof, or
  - c) He/she should have resided in Delhi for the last five years, for which he/she has to produce domicile certificate or any other proof of residence in Delhi.

Should be issued caste certificate as original resident of Delhi.

- II. For this purpose attestation of the application by the Member of Parliament/Member of Legislative Assembly/Municipal Councilor or Member of SC/ST Welfare Boards/Gazetted Officer as usual should be accepted as proof of genuineness of the applicant.
- III. Verification of the parent's certificate from the original issuing authority should be done away unless there is a specific complaint against the applicant giving rise to serious doubts about genuineness of the original certificate.
- IV. Those Scheduled Caste migrant applicants who do not fulfill any of the above three conditions mentioned in para (I) can be issued caste certificate in the prescribed format for migrants, as hitherto being done.

These recommendations of the Committee have been accepted by the Government, vide Cabinet Decision No. 963 dated 7.5.2005. Therefore, all the Deputy Commissioners are directed to give wide publicity and follow these instructions scrupulously and ensure that the Sub Divisional Magistrates issue the Scheduled Caste certificates accordingly.


