**CIRCULAR**

Vide Cabinet Decision No. 2022 dated 20/5/2013, it has been decided to levy a penalty of 10% of the duty involved pertaining to the respective transport permit, if any retailer refuses to accept the consignment received for whatsoever reason. However, the licencing authority in exceptional circumstances and for reasons to be recorded in writing may exempt the retailer from payment of the proposed penalty amount.

Accordingly, all concerned licencees are hereby directed to accept the consignment of liquor delivered to them on a valid Transport Permit, failing which the aforesaid penalty provision shall be invoked.
