SUB: - Recreational avenues for children to control drug/substance abuse.

Hon'ble Juvenile Justice Committee, High Court of Delhi is holding periodic meetings with stakeholders of the state to sensitize and create awareness for prevention of Drug/Substance Abuse among children.

As per the action plan of Directorate of Education, it is desired that following recreational avenues be provided for children of all schools so that their attention is engaged in more positive activities.

- Dramatic activities like role play, nukkar natak etc. based on awareness regarding ill effects of substance use in morning assembly.
- Talk by school teacher/guest speaker in morning assembly to motivate the students.
- Provide information on ill effects & prevention part of substance abuse through film show, C.D. etc. in CAL Labs.
- Having painting competition, slogan competition etc. under Yuva club activities at school level.
- Intensive Yoga and sports activities daily in schools to channelize the energy of students.
- Display of Helpline Numbers on bulletin boards at prominent places of the school.
- Skits, debate, extempore, essay writing etc. for creating awareness regarding substance abuse problems should be included at Zonal level under cultural activities competition.

Compliance of the instructions would be periodically checked through inspections etc.
