CIRCULAR

Sub: Admissions to class XI in Humanities/ Vocational Streams for the Session 2014-15.

The result for class X was declared on 20th May 2014 for the session 2013-14. All HOSs are to ensure that their OWN STUDENTS / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL STUDENTS are given admission in class XI in Humanities & Vocational Streams manually.

The admissions for <u>Humanities & Vocational streams</u> have started immediately after the declaration of class X results. The admission criteria will be the same as in the last year (copy of circular enclosed).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE (Manual) for Govt. Aided / Feeder Private /Recognized Private / Other School.

All the Heads of Govt. schools are directed to adhere to the following instructions in letter and spirit while preparing the merit list for the following categories of students:

- · Govt. Aided school students.
- Feeder Pvt. School students as per Admission Plan.
- Outside students/Public School Students.
- Application forms for such Admissions are to be filled and submitted by the students directly in the school where they seek admission.
- The merit lists for <u>Humanities & Vocational streams</u> will be prepared separately as ML-2 for students of Govt. Aided schools, ML-3 for Feeder Private School students as per admission plan and ML-4 for students of Other Schools.

- 3. The merit lists ML-2, ML-3, ML-4 will be prepared separately for each stream as per the criteria given in the circular no.DE.23(28)/Sch.Br/08/606 dated 28/05/2012.
- 4. The Heads of Schools must ensure that first of all, the eligible students of their OWN SCHOOL / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL shall be given admission. Only after all the students of OWN SCHOOL / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL have been admitted, then the HOS will consider ML-2.
- 5. Importantly, admissions will be given to ML-2 i.e. Govt. Aided School students only if seats are vacant after giving admissions to Govt. School Students.
- 6. If seats are still available, then admissions will be given to Feeder Private School Students as per admission plan (ML-3) and thereafter, Public School / outside students (ML-4) in strict order of merit list. The CBSE / Concerned Board roll numbers of such students must be mentioned in the merit list and grades of the concerned students must be properly checked and verified by the Head of School. In order to observe transparency in admission procedure, Heads of schools are hereby directed to prepare Merit lists 2, 3 & 4 for Humanities and Vocational Streams by taking into account all applications received in the school. In addition to above, the following instructions should also be complied with:
- Prepare the merit lists including CGPA & Grade points of their required subjects (as per circular no.DE.23(28)/Sch.Br/08/606 dated 28/05/2012.
- The HOS has to prepare the merit lists according to the total grade points keeping in view that a student must have obtained minimum qualifying grades in each subject as per admission criteria for Humanities and Vocational streams.
- It is also important to note that just <u>getting minimum qualifying grade & CGPA</u> does not guarantee admission in a particular stream.
- The Education Officers are also directed to monitor the admission process personally and closely and it is their responsibility to ensure that no rules are violated. Transparency is to be maintained at all levels.
- HOSs must ensure compliance of circular no. DE.23(28)/Sch.Br/08/606 dated 28/05/2012).
- The last date for admission is 31st July 2014 at the level of HOS for class XI.

A student declared passed at the Secondary school examination and getting following grades(without astrix) are eligible for admissions in Class XI.

All HOS are hereby informed that relaxation of 1 grade point in any one of the three subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream is to be given in respect of candidates belonging to the following categories i.e. for SC/ST,handicapped, Kashmere Migrants & those students having I,II,III position in National Games.

Admission of compartment students. The schedule and procedure for admission of compartment students shall be completed within 10 days of the declaration of class 10th result as per above criteria.
