There is no entry fee for participation in this tournament.


In case of any dispute, the decision of Technical Committee will be final.

**RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES**  
**Government of NCT of Delhi Inter Zonal Chess Tournament**

1. Latest FIDE Laws shall be observed to conduct the Inter Zonal Chess Tournament unless, otherwise, mentioned in these rules.
2. The Tournament will be played in three sections (separately for Boys & Girls) Sub Junior (U-14), Junior (U-17) & seniors (U-19) age groups. **The participant are requested to bring their own chess boards and chess clocks to help in smooth and timely conduct of tournament.**
3. The tournament will be played on Swiss league basis and pairing will be done by computer only.
4. The walk-over time shall be 15 minutes from start of the game.
5. Every school can send maximum five entries in each age group. Total number of rounds will be decided only after receiving all the entries. Entries must be submitted latest by 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 i.e. one day before start of the tournament. **No entry shall be entertained after last date.**
6. There will be a meeting of School representatives (Physical Education In charge / Manager), tournament organizers & Arbiters before start of first round.
7. Time control will be 90 minutes each player with 30 second increment on each move (Fischer mode) will be observed. Minimum ten minutes will be given to each player when clocks are introduced at a later stage.
8. Tie – Break: following tie-breaking procedures will be observed;
  - (a) Sum of the game scores of all the opponents (Buchholz)
  - (b) Median Buchholz.
9. All players must obey rules and regulations, Arbiters decision will be final & abiding. Parents/Coaches/school representatives are not allowed in tournament hall.
10. **Use of mobile phones and other electric equipments are prohibited.** Mobile should be in switch off mode while playing. If a player's mobile rings during the game, he will be declared lost and the point will be awarded to the opponent.
11. Any misbehavior, shouting or misconduct on the part of player/parents or school representative will result in the expulsion of participant/school from the tournament.
