CIRCULAR

It has come to the notice that the vends selling liquor against P-10 permit do not mention the bar code and batch number of liquor sold on the bill/cash memo, which makes it open for manipulation and further misuse of P-10 permit for carrying unauthorized liquor. The competent authority has taken a very serious view regarding this lapse on part of retail vends.

All the retail liquor vend licensees are hereby directed to mention the case/bottle bar code number and batch number of liquor in the bill/cash memos with respect to liquor sold against P-10 permit with immediate effect failing which penal action as deemed fit shall be initiated against the defaulters as per the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and Delhi Excise Rule, 2010.
