The Indian Army is commemorating the centenary of the First World War. During this Great War, India contributed over 1.5 million men out of which 74,000 were killed and over 67,000 were wounded in various battle fields in Europe, Africa and Asia. The gallantry and sacrifice of the Indian Soldiers was recognized by award of 11 Victoria Crosses and 9,700 other awards. To mark the centenary of the Great War various commemorative events are being organized.

In this series, a commemorative exhibition with them "India and World War-I" showcasing the gallantry and sacrifice of Indian soldiers in the first World war has been organized at the Manekshaw Centre, Delhi Cantt. from 10th March onwards. Exhibition was inaugurated by the President on 10th March, 2015. The exhibition promises to take one back to the World War-I era showcasing the living conditions of the Indian soldiers during the war.
