## Sub- To conduct summer workshops for children in Government schools.

The Sahitya Kala Parishad is an academy of Music, Dance, Theatre and Fine arts & crafts under the Department of Art, Culture & Languages, Delhi Government, which works for the promotion and propagation of art and culture in the Capital.

Of the many initiatives Parishad takes, one of the most prominent is that of conducting summer workshops in Music, Dance, Theatre and Fine arts & crafts and Lok Kala for children in over 40-50 different localities of Delhi with the objective to inculcate and encourage the creative talent in them.

As last year, this year also the Parishad will be happy to collaborate with the Department of Education, Government of Delhi to conduct these workshops in Government schools. In all 50 workshops will be held. Accordingly 50 Government schools can become Centers for these workshops. It is requested that 4-5 centers in different district / parts of the city may be selected so that the whole of Delhi can be covered.

The schools shall have to facilitate only in the following manner:- adequate space, a hall which can accommodate 40-50 children doing movements with amenities such as lights, drinking water and hygienic toilets for the participants. Each school shall also provide one nodal officer to coordinate with the Parishad during these workshops.

These workshops will be conducted from 18/5/2015 to 17/6/2015 from 8.00 a.m. to 11.00a.m. in which children from the nearby localities can register themselves. It may be noted that at each center (school) approximately 40 children will be accommodated from which 20 children will be from the center/ school itself and the rest would be from the nearby localities.

The Parishad shall provide Directors and Assistant Directors to conduct these workshops and to train the children in various categories mentioned above. These workshops are held free of cost for the benefit of children and are widely advertised in National Newspapers. All publicity material shall include the name of the department of education, as a collaborator.

Your kind cooperation would strengthen our efforts in reaching out to the young talents in Delhi by providing them with a platform to showcase their talent.

We would appreciate a word of confirmation in this regard from your end and request you to provide the list of schools at the earliest by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2015.
