#### Circular

#### Sub: Admissions to Class XI in Humanities / Vocational streams for the session 2015-16.

All Heads of Govt. Schools are to ensure that their OWN STUDENTS / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOLS STUDENTS are given admission in class XI in Humanities & Vocational streams.

The admissions for Humanities & Vocational streams will start immediately after the declaration of class X results. The admission criteria will be the same as in the last year (copy of circular dated 28.05.2012 enclosed).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE (Manual) for Govt. Aided/Feeder Private/Recognized Private/Other Schools.

All the Heads of Govt. schools are directed to adhere to the following instructions in letter and spirit while preparing the merit list for the following categories of students:

- Govt. Aided school students.
- Feeder Private School students as per Admission Plan.
- Public School Students/Outside Students.
- Application form along with filled option form for such Admission are to be submitted by the students directly in the school where they seek admission.
- The common Merit List (ML-2) for all students of Govt. Aided, Feeder private, Recognized Private and other schools will be prepared for Humanities and Vocational stream separately.
- The eligibility criteria are same as given in the circular no. DE.23 (28)/Sch.Br./08/606 dated 28-05-2012.
- 4. The Heads of Schools must ensure that first of all the eligible students of their OWN SCHOOL / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL shall be given admission. Only after all the students of OWN SCHOOL / GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL have been admitted and if seats are vacant then the HOS will consider ML-2.
- 5. The CBSE / Concerned Board roll numbers of such students must be mentioned in the merit list and grades of the concerned students must be properly checked and verified by the Head of School. In order to observe transparency in admission procedure. Heads of Schools are hereby directed to prepare merit lists for Humanities and Vocational streams by taking into account all applications received in the school.
- 6. In addition to above the following instruction should also be complied with:

- Prepare the merit lists including CGPA & Grade points of the required subjects (as per circular no. DE.23 (28)/Sch.Br./08/606 dated 28-05-2012).
- The HOS has to prepare the merit list according to the total grade points keeping in view that a student must have obtained minimum qualifying grades in each subject as per admission criteria for Humanities & Vocational streams.
- It is also important to note that just getting minimum qualifying grade & CGPA does not guarantee admission in a particular stream.
- The DDEs (Zone) are also directed to monitor the admission process personally and closely and it is their responsibility to ensure that no rules are violated. Transparency is to be maintained at all levels.
- HOSs must ensure compliance of circular no. DE.23(28)/Sch.Br./08/606 dated 28-05-2012 and circular no. DE.23 (28)/Sch.Br./865 dated 02-07-2013 (copy enclosed).
- The outside students may be granted admission in Humanities & Vocational streams as per eligibility criteria only after granting admission to all the eligible students of OWN SCHOOL and GOVT. FEEDER SCHOOL.
- The subject in which the students failed in class X cannot be opted in class XI.
- For giving Economics as a subject a student must have at least 6.00 CGPA.
- For giving Mathematics as a subject a student must have secured at least C1 Grade in Mathematics.
- It has been noticed that some invalid combination of subjects are being offered to students which are creating problem at CBSE / University level. All Heads of Schools are to offer those subjects which are in line with CBSE guidelines as well as applicable at admission at university level.
- The last date for admission is 31<sup>st</sup> July 2015 at the level of HOS for class XI.

Declaration of Merit lists (if required). Last date for admission in class XI.
