Dear Sir/Madam.

With reference to the above, it is to inform you that, following decisions regarding participation of School players were taken in the General Council Meeting of School Games Federation of India held on 9th & 10th June 2015 at LNIPE Guwahat Assam :-

- Any School Player cannot participate in the same Age Group for more than Three NSGs.
- 2. Any player of Primary school cannot participate in the Age groups allotted for the Junior Schools (i.e. U-14 and above) in the National School Games of Calendar 2015-16.

The above decisions have created a lot of confusions & discrepancies among various Units/organizations etc. Therefore, in view of the above facts, SGFI office clarifies as under:-

Any School player can participate in any discipline, in the same Age group for Three years/NSG only. However, if a player of Primary school has participated for three years in one Age Group and have advanced to the Junior School, then his previous participations will not prevent him to participate in the tournaments of Junior School. He can again participate for Three years/NSG in any one Age Group allotted

for Junior Schools.
