
CIRCULAR

Please refer to Govt of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Dept of Sports letter No. 7-1/2009-SP-IV dated 03 Sep 2010 addressed to the State/UT Sports Director and State/UT Disability Commissioner and letter No. 7-1/2009-SP-IV DATED 07 July 2010 addressed to Chairman, Special Olympics Bharat (SOB) designating SOB as the Nodal Agency to conduct Master Trainers Training at LNIPE Gwalior .



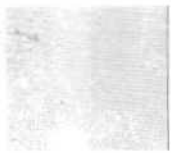
