Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that INSPIRE Award Scheme has been shifted to Direct Benefit Transfer Platform from 1St April, 2015. Thus, INSPIRE Award amount of Rs.5000/- each is being transferred directly into the Bank accounts of the awardees.

- Further, it has been decided that INSPIRE Award Warrants issued by State Bank of India, Parliament Street New Delhi, before 1st April, 2015 will be valid only till 31st March, 2016. Henceforth, no such warrants issued will be honoured by the bank and will not be valid for encashment.
