Under the "INSPIRE Award' component of the scheme, during the five year plan period, two students are selected from each school of the country, which has any of the classes from 6° to 10° standard, for an INSPIRE Award of Rs. 5000/each for preparing a science project/model. These awardees then participate in a 3- tier competition at district, State and National level. The main contents of the letter are as under

Phase-I The participants of INSPIRE Award would be required to put forward their creative ideas/concepts/innovations on specific themes having relevance to local a rince and technology needs and national priorities.

Some of the illustrative themes for preparation of Exhibits/Models could be as under:-

Board Theme	Sub Theme (Illustrative Examples)
Make in India	New Tool and techniques for manufacturing New Technologies New Materials.
Swachch Bharat	 Waste Management/Municipal solid waste disposal, recycling etc Hospital Waste Disposal Industrial Waste Disposal Clean Energy Reduction of Pollution Cleaning of Water Bodies, Rivers etc Green Toilet
Swasth Bharat	Rural Sanitation Preventive Healthcare (Hygiene and Sanitation) Traditional and alternative medicines Lifestyle Management Awareness Creation
Digital India	 Digital Solutions for Education, Healthcare. Governance, Smart Cities and Smart Villages etc.

The participants may be asked to work on the concepts which are related to one of these themes. The concept should suggest ways and means to provide solution to one of these national priorities with specific reference to local needs. The concept note of 2.3 pages including sketches, diagrams, etc. may be submitted by the participants. A rudimentary model may also be submitted to buttress the concept.



Every effort should be made to rule out tendency of procuring ready made Exhibits/Models by the participants. During evaluation process, emphasis should be given to creativity of the concept rather than the physical model. General layout of Model, its relevance, clarity of charts accompanying the Exhibit/Model and overall alignment to theme, be assessed.

Phase-II The ideas/concepts selected in the first phase may be followed up by asking the students to further fine tune the concept and demonstrate it in a working model.

All District DDEs and District Nodal Officer (DNO), INSPIRE are requested to go through the original letter of the DST before furnishing the information to this office.
