As you are aware, Government e-Marketplace (GeM) has been developed by DGS&D with technical support of NeCD (MeitY) on the directions of Government. The portal was launched on 9th August, 2016. GeM is totally an end-to-end online marketplace for common use goods and services required by Government buyers providing greater transparency and efficiency. Presently 29 Product categories with offers for about 1500 products from more than 700 Sellers are available on GeM. In addition, hiring of transport service has also been listed on GeM with 140+ vehicle offers from 46+ Service providers. Within a short span of time, procurement worth more than Rs. 20 crore has been made through GeM. I am glad to share with you that transactions so far have revealed substantial savings especially when bidding have been done.

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2. Procurement on GeM has been enabled by amendment to GFR (Rule 141A). Further, Deptt. of Expenditure through an OM has mandated payment within 10 days of acceptance of goods/services to the suppliers. GeM has already been integrated with PFMS for Central Government Ministries and with State Bank Multi Option Payment System (SBMOPS) for direct payment through the banking channel. Details may please be seen at gem.gov.in. GeM can be integrated with State payment system.

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3. DGS&D is ready to provide one day demonstration cum training to State Government officers engaged in procurement of common use goods and services at State Hqrs. In addition, DGS&D is also willing to hand-hold the procurement officers of your Department for registration as well as issuing bids and Reverse Auction on GeM. Request to this effect may be sent to Shri Aman Sharma, Director (GeM), aman.dgsnd@gov.in

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4. I would request you to please instruct all your officers to start using GeM for their requirements of common use goods and services. You may also consider providing enabling provision in any financial or procurement rules, if required.
