C I R C U L A R

All the Empanelled Hospitals of this Corporation have been asked to follow the rate list of CGHS and the rate list of Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi, failing which DTC is free to think over their discontinuation of empanellment. They have also been asked to send their consent in this regard.

It has therefore been decided that all such Empanelled Hospitals who will charge higher rates from DTC employees as compared to the rates being charged by them from the employees of Govt. of Delhi should be depanelled.

Chief Medical Officer shall be responsible to all necessary arrangements for proper verification of the Medical Bills and necessary instructions be issued to the para medical staff that the excess amount charged by any empanelled Hospital should be deducted then and there and information regarding excess charges be sent to this office enabling us to initiate action for depenelling the defaulting Hospital.

Similar exercise must be adopted while verifying the amount of advance cases, where advance amount is required to be paid as per the estimate given by the hospital, so that employee may not face any problem at a later stage for the reimbursement.

Accounts Deptt. may also ensure that the above instructions are adhered to while vetting the medical claim bills of the employees, so that no excess payment is made to any of the employee, empanelled Hospital neither at the time of giving advance nor at the time of final settlement.

All Unit Officers are directed to ensure that a thorough check is made in respect of all the medical bills while recommending the cases for sanctioning the advance as well as at the time of making final settlement of the medical bills and it must be ensured that no empanelled Hospital is paid more than the amount charged by them from the employees of Delhi Govt. and the rate list of Delhi Govt./C.G.H.S. is followed strictly. Simultaneously it should also be given wide publicity among the officers/employees so that they may also make necessary enquiry in this regard from the empanelled Hospitals while taking treatment from them to avoid future complication in their reimbursement.

The above orders shall take immediate effect.
