- (c) No District should submit more than 4(Four) recommendations (2 in Primary Category and 2 in Secondary Category).

Subject: National Award to Teachers, 2016 - Allocation of Awards to States / Union Territories / Organisations - Request for recommendations.

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy implements a Scheme of 'National Award to Teachers' (www.mhrd.gov.in) as per which teachers from all over the country are selected for National Awards. The following categories of teachers are eligible for award under this Scheme:

Recognized Primary and Secondary School Teachers of States/UTs/Organisation;

> Arabic/Persian Teachers of Madrasas run on traditional lines; (iii)

(iv) Teachers of CBSE affiliated schools;*

Teachers of CISCE affiliated schools: (v)

(vi) Teachers of CTSA affiliated Schools; and

(vii) Teachers who promote the education of children with disability in regular schools by States/UTs/Organisations and other school system.

Sanskrit Teachers of Sanskrit Pathshalas and Tolls run on traditional lines;

*The teachers recommended by CBSE should be other than those who have already been covered under the allocated quota for States/UTs/Organisations.

The States/ UTs/Organisations wise quota for National Awards is given at Annexure-I.

- For Sanskrit Teachers of Sanskrit Pathshalas and Tolls, 15 awards are reserved 3. and for Arabic/Persian Teachers of Madrasas 5 awards are reserved, which cannot be allocated State-wise due to their limited number. Selection of teachers for these awards will, therefore, be made out of all the names that would be recommended by various States/Union Territories. At least two names may be recommended for these categories of teachers. From past experience, it is noticed that recommendations for these awards are not adequate. You are, therefore, requested to make special efforts to locate suitable Sanskrit and Arabic/Persian Teachers of Institutions run on traditional lines so that the Awards do not lapse. There are a large number of traditional Pathshalas/Tolls/Madrasas functioning in different parts of the country. However, since they may be functioning in an informal way or do not come to the notice of the Education authorities, special efforts need to be made to identify them and recommend their teachers for the National Awards, if they fulfill the necessary conditions.
- 4. It has been noticed that Sanskrit/Arabic/Persian teachers working in regular schools are generally not considered for National Award by the States due to a misunderstanding that such teachers would be eligible exclusively for awards from out of the 15 and 5 awards set apart for Sanskrit and Arabic/Persian Teachers of traditional Pathshalas and Madrasas. It is requested that Sanskrit and Arabic/Persian teachers working in regular Primary/Secondary schools should also be considered for National Award under the categories of Primary and Secondary school teachers.
- 5. You are also requested to give suitable representation to women teachers while making your recommendations as it has been noticed that sufficient number of women teachers are not recommended by the States. It may be noted that for class room teachers only 15 years of regular teaching experience is required, while for Principals/Headmasters 20 years of regular teaching service is required. However, for the Special award category, in case of teachers, 10 years of regular teaching experience and for Principals/Headmasters, 15 years of regular teaching experience is required.
- 6. While recommending the teachers, the State Committee/Central Award Committee shall categorically state the SPECIAL OR UNIQUE attribute of each teacher on the basis of which their names have been recommended. Absence of such information may render the teacher(s) ineligible for the award.

- 7. A brief citation is required to be attached for teachers being recommended under the categories for *special awards*. If no suitable candidate is recommended, the allocated special awards shall not be transferred to general category. Other eligibility conditions and the selection procedure remain unchanged. Deserving teachers should, therefore, be encouraged in the interest of education by recommending sufficient number of such teachers who may themselves have disabilities and also those who have done commendable work for education of children with disabilities.
- (i) A copy of the minutes of the meeting of the State/UTs/Organisation Selection Committee finalising the recommendations may also invariably be sent, in original duly signed by all committee members. This is vital and may please be noted for compliance.
- (ii) It may be reiterated that complete information as per the proforma is to be sent. There must be no deviation from the prescribed proforma. Recommendations with incomplete information will not be processed.
- 8. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter and ensure that your recommendations reach this Ministry as early as possible and in any case not later than **28.02.2017** positively. I shall be grateful if a soft copy of the recommendation of the State Selection Committee along with enclosures is e-mailed to natsection2014@gmail.com.
- 9. It has been observed in the past that some States/UTs/Organisations send recommendations much later than the last date for receipt causing avoidable delay in the finalization of awards. It is, therefore, reiterated that nominations in the prescribed proforma only must be sent in time so as to ensure that the awards are finalized and necessary action is taken for their distribution on 05.09.2017.
- 10. It is also requested that a copy of Aadhaar Card and Bank details/mandate form (Proforma enclosed) of the recommended teachers may be sent to this department for on-line disbursement of award money and Travelling Allowances (TA).

NATIONAL AWARD TO TEACHERS

The Scheme of National Award to Teachers was started in the year 1958-59 with the object of raising the prestige of teachers and giving public recognition to the meritorious services of outstanding teachers working in Primary, Middle and Higher Secondary Schools. In 1967-68 the scope of the scheme was enlarged to cover the teachers of Sanskrit Pathshalas, Tolls etc. run on traditional lines. In 1976 the scheme was further enlarged to cover Arabic/Persian teachers of Madrasas.

From the award year 1993, the scheme has further been enlarged to cover teachers from Sainik Schools, Navodaya Vidyalayas and schools run by Atomic Energy Education Society. Earlier CBSE had been allocated a quota of 10 awards – 2 for each zone subject to availability in case of shortfall of recommendation from the entitled States/UTs and organizations. Each award carries with it a certificate of merit, a cash award money of Rs.50,000/- and a Silver Medal. The enhanced amount will be given to the National Awardee from the Award year, 2014.

- 2. The number of awards has been increased from 302 to 350 from the award year 2000-2001. 4 additional Awards have been allocated to CBSE from the Award year, 2002. From the award year 2006 the total number of award earmarked to KVS have been increased from 6 to 16. The number of awards further increased from the award year 2007. The number of awards at present stands at 378. The break up of which is as under:
- (I) 355 Awards

States/UTs, Kendriya Vidyalayas, Navodaya Vidyalayas, Atomic Energy Education Society, Sainik Schools, Sanskrit And Arabic/Persian teachers.

- (II) 6 Awards
- Teachers of Council for Indian Schools Certificate Examination (CISCE) affiliated schools.
- (III) 20Awards

Teachers of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) affiliated schools. The National Awards belonging to CBSE would comprise of awards to 2 teachers each for Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western and North-Eastern, Delhi Zones and 2

Slots for the teachers of independent affiliated schools situated abroad. The teachers

recommended by CBSE should be other than those who have already been covered under the allocated quota for States/UTs/ Organizations.

(IV) 43 Awards

Teachers promoting Integrated Inclusive Education (IE) in Schools. These "Special" awards would be given to teachers who promote the education of children with disabilities in regular schools run by States/UTs and other schools system. Such awards would be given to the following categories of teachers.

- Teachers with disabilities working in regular schools.
- Special teachers or trained general teachers who may have done outstanding work for Inclusive Education.

I. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY OF TEACHERS FOR CONSIDERATION FOR THE AWARDS:

- 1. Classroom teachers with atleast 15 years regular teaching experience and Headmasters with 20 years of regular teaching experience and who are actually working as teachers/headmasters in recognized primary/middle/high/ higher secondary schools only shall be considered. Teachers who are teaching upto class VIII should be considered in the category of Primary School Teachers and those teaching classes IX-XII, in the category of Secondary School Teachers. For teachers promoting Integrated Inclusive Education the eligibility will stand reduced from 15 years of classroom teaching experience to 10 years of service and from 20 years for Headmasters to 15 years if they are to be considered for awards in respect of Inclusive Education.
- 2. Normally retired teachers are not eligible for the award but those teachers who have served a part of the calendar year (at least for four months i.e. upto 30th April in the year to which National Award relates) may be considered if they fulfill all other conditions. The service rendered on re-employment after attaining the age of superannuation will not count as eligible service.

- Teachers whose names were recommended last year or before can be considered again if they are still otherwise eligible and are recommended by the State Government/ Union Territories.
- Educational Administrators, Inspectors of Education, and the staff of training colleges are not eligible for these awards.
- 5. Only those teachers, having requisite years of teaching experience, as mentioned at Sl.No.1 above, on 31st December of the preceding year of the Award, will be eligible to be considered for the award.

II. MAIN CONSIDERATIONS THAT SHOULD GUIDE THE SELECTION OF TEACHERS AT VARIOUS LEVELS:

- 1. Teachers' reputation in the local community;
- 2. His/her academic efficiency and desire for its improvement.
- 3. His/her genuine interest in and love for children; and
- 4. His/her involvement in the social life of the community.

III. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:

- The initial selection shall be made at the District level by a District Committee from amongst the names recommended by the District Education Officer, a District Inspector of schools or such other local authorities e.g. Corporation, Panchayat etc. which the State Government may determine in the context of local conditions. No teacher shall be asked or permitted to apply for the award. The names shall be recommended by the District Education Officer etc. on the basis of the Teachers' record of work.
- 2. The State Selection Committee shall scrutinize and sift the recommendations of the District Committee and recommend to the State Government two names for each award allotted to the State and one or two names of Sanskrit/Arabic teachers if found suitable. The names of teachers selected by the State Committee shall be arranged in order of merit before they are recommended to the State Government who shall forward the same to the Union Government alongwith character certificate of faultless antecedents and absolute integrity duly signed by the Education Secretary. The recommendations of the State Selection Committee shall not be modified by the State Government to substitute names, or to disturb the order of merit recommended by the State Selection

committee. However, if the State Government is of the view that any of the selected teacher is otherwise unfit for the award, it may recommend omission of such names to the Union Government furnishing details for the same.

- 3. The State/UTs/School systems shall recommend at least the prescribed number of awards under the category "Special Awards". In case they do not find suitable number of teachers under this category, the award will not be recommended, but in that situation the number of allocated awards for special award shall not be transferred to the general category.
- 4. The final selection will be made by the Union Government.

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

However, if the organization is of the view that any of the selected teachers is otherwise unfit for the award, it may recommend omission of such names to the Union Government furnishing details of the same.
- 3. The Organization shall recommend at least the prescribed number of awards under the category "Special Awards". In case they do not find suitable number of teachers under this category, the award will not be recommended. But in that situation the number of awards for the category "Special Awards" shall not be transferred to the general category.
- 4. The final selection will be made by the Union Government.
