Sir/Madam,



The Indian Red Cross Society, together with its partners, i.e. the ICRC and the IFRC, has decided to organize

1. Online essay and photography competitions. These shall be open to all. The entries shall be judged by a panel of judges and the three winners from each category shall be felicitated.

a. Topic for essay : IRCS - Beyond the Century - My Vision (word limit – 500).

Entries should be mailed on : essaycompetition@indianredcross.org

b. Topic for Photography competition: IRCS - My Experience over Century.

Entries should be mailed on : photographycompetition@indianredcross.org(jpeg format)

Last date for receipt of all entrees : 24 April, 2017(11.59pm)

Declaration of results : 1st May, 2017

Following may also be noted by the contestants:

- a. **Only top three entries shall receive prize/certificate.**
- b. **There is no entry fee.**
- c. **Employees and family members of the Red Cross Staff are not eligible to participate.**
- d. **Language : English.**
- e. **All entries shall become Red Cross property.**
- f. **Only one entry per contestant is permitted.**

g. Decision of the jury shall be final.

2. All the branches are also advised to organize a Health Camp on the World Red Cross Day. One or multiple of the following suggested services and/or services needed by the local community may be provided -:

- a. Height & weight (BMI for malnutrition)
- b. Blood sugar (diabetes)
- c. Blood grouping
- d. Blood pressure
- e. Hypertension
- f. Disability identification
- g. Distribution of aids and appliances to differently abled etc.

All the IRCS branches are requested to disseminate the information widely for wider coverage and better response.

All the contestants must send the entries directly through e mail to the IRCS National Headquarters on the designated email ids only.

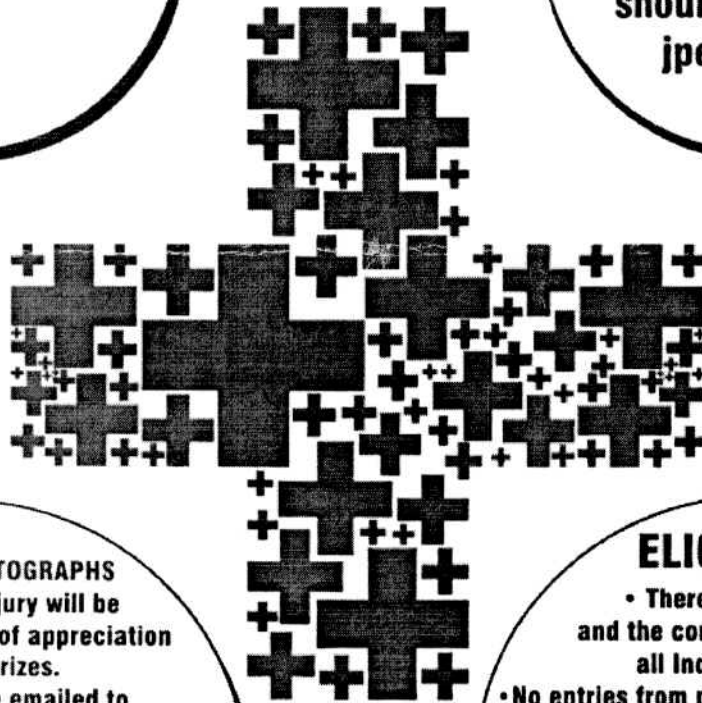
