### Sub: - <u>Reg. School Class boundation in the SGFI National School Games for different age</u> categories and Khelo India National School Games 2017.

Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi is pleased to convey the decision taken by SGFI to abolish school class boundation for different age categories in the SGFI National School Games with effect from the session 2017-18. So all those deserving talented players who were previously denied chances to participate in the SGFI NSGs due to school class boundation can now compete in the same subject to the following terms and conditions:

- Any student/player who has passed his XII standard will <u>NOT</u> be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs irrespective of being in any age category.
- For the age categories Under-14,17 & 19 any student/player studying below VI standard will <u>NOT</u> be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs.
- For the age category Under-11, any student/player studying below III standard will <u>NOT</u> be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs. He/She must be the student of Class III/IV/V.
- If any student/player is studying in Class XI and is participating in the age category Under-17, then he/she has to submit High School Certificate/Marksheet with his SGFI eligibility form.
- 5. Student/Players must possess a valid Aadhar Card to participate in the SGFI NSGs.
