CIRCULAR

Sub: - Inter Zonal Chess competition in Under-14, 17 & 19 years (Boys & Girls) for Delhi school students.

Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi intends to organize Inter Zonal Chess competition in Under-14,17 & 19 years (Boys & Girls) for Delhi school students w.e.f. 24.10.2017 to 27.10.2017 at Chhatrasal Stadium, Model Town, Delhi as per details given below:

Age Category	Time	Eligibility
Under-14	9.00 A.M.	Student should be born on or after 01.01.2004
Under-17	11.00 A.M.	Student should be born on or after 01.01.2001
Under-19	1.00 P.M.	Student should be born on or after 01.01.1999
The participants should be a student of up to 12 <sup>th</sup> class but not below 6 <sup>th</sup> class		

The interested players should bring their entry in the enclosed prescribed proforma at Annexure-I, duly attested by the Head of the School at the above mentioned venue till 18.10.2017. The stamp of the Head of the school on the proforma should be clearly visible and legible. The stamp on the photo of the student should have been affixed in such a manner that the half of it should be on the photo and half on the proforma. The players will have to report in the proper playing kit and must bring their school ID proof with them.


Note:

1. The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya are not eligible to participate in the above competition.
2. The copy of birth certificate of the student, issued by Municipal Authority, is to be enclosed. The birth of the child should have been registered by the Municipal authority within one year of the birth of the student. In case it is not so, then the student will have to furnish details of his educational qualification from nursery onwards in the proforma enclosed at Annexure-II.
3. In case of need, a student might have to undergo medical examination for age verification from the Govt. hospital.
4. In case of any dispute, protest can be lodged with protest fees of Rs.500/-, within one hour of completion of the bout. No request would be allowed after the stipulated time.
5. A School can send maximum 5 entries for boys and 5 entries for girls in each age group (U/-14,17&19 separately).
6. Decision of the Technical Committee would be final.
7. All the participants should bring their own Chess set.
8. A player can participate in only one age category in that particular year.

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9. The selected players will represent Delhi in 63<sup>rd</sup> National School Games to be held at Warangal, Telangana w.e.f. 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2017.

# Inter Zonal Chess Tournament

## **RULES & REGULATIONS** (Under 14, 17, 19 Boys and Girls)

1. The Tournament will be played in three sections (separately for Boys & Girls) Sub Junior (U-14), Junior (U-17) & seniors (U-19) age groups. The participant shall bring their own chess boards to help in smooth and timely conduct of tournament.
2. Latest FIDE Laws shall be observed to conduct the Tournament unless otherwise, mentioned in these rules.
3. A school can send maximum 5 entries for boys and 5 entries for girls in each age group (U-14, 17 & 19 years separately).
4. Total number of rounds will be decided only after receiving all the entries. Entries must be submitted by 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2016. No entry shall be entertained after last date.
5. Walk-over time shall be 30 minutes from start of the game.
6. Use of mobile phones and other electronic devices is strictly prohibited during the game. If a player's mobile rings during the game or if a mobile is found with him/her in switched on mode, the point will be awarded to the opponent and the player with the mobile will be declared lost.
7. Parents/Coaches/school representatives are not allowed in tournament hall.
8. Arbiter's decision will be final & binding to all the players.
9. Any misbehavior, shouting or misconduct on the part of player/parents or school representative will result in the expulsion of participant/school from the tournament.
