CIRCULAR

Time and again an emphasis has been laid down by the Secretary (I&FC) and Chief Secretary, Delhi for monitoring of all the court cases in order to ensure filling of timely reply by the Department in the court. Further, all the steps which are necessary to protect the interest of Govt. are to be taken by the concerned branch In-Charge. However despite this there is a need to be more effective vigilant approach in the monitoring of court cases. Therefore in order to have a well-organized mechanism in place for monitoring of court cases at all level and to fix responsibility and accountability, it has been desired by the competent authority to adhere to the policy of monitoring of court cases as per instruction given below:-

1. A monthly review will be held in the chamber of Chief Engineer in r/o all the court cases pending in different courts.
2. All the Superintending Engineer are required to first have a review of all the court cases pertaining to their Divisions at their own level and report thereof be submitted to the O/o Chief Engineer only with reference to such cases which require intervention at the level of Chief Engineer (I&FC).
3. Similarly, all the Ex. Engineer are required to first have a review of all the court cases pertaining to their Division at their own level and report thereof be submitted to the O/o Superintending Engineer with reference to only such cases which require intervention at the level of Superintending Engineer.
4. A consolidated report of all the cases with latest progress report be furnished to the Headquarter latest by 7th of the following month to the preceding month on the prescribed format already circulated along with the review report as prescribed above.

The review and monitoring of court cases has also been taken seriously by the Govt. The Chief Secretary, Delhi has given instruction in this regard which are to be followed by the Deptt., in order to avoid any adverse comments of the court. It is therefore the primary duty and responsibility of the Circle/ Division In-charge to review and monitor such cases without fail and also to apprise the Headquarter with the outcome as the format, as stated in point.-4.
