CIRCULAR

Employees Compensation Act,1923 is a employees' welfare legislation providing for compensation to the employees or his dependents for injury or death arising out of and in the course of employment. It is applicable on 'employers' which are not covered by Employees State Insurance Act,1948.

In many cases the Government engages employees/executes works/projects through the contractor and these employees are the workers of the Contractors and liability to pay compensation for injury or death of the employees primarily lies with the contractor and in view of section 4A of the Employees Compensation Act it shall be paid as soon as it falls due. If the compensation is not paid within one month from the date it fell due, the Commissioner shall direct payment of interest. Further, section 4A3(b) of the Act empowers the Commissioner to impose penalty upto 50% of the amount after issuing notice and affording opportunity of hearing to the employer.

The Hon'ble High Court in the matter FAO 339/2016, M/s Simplex Infrastructure Ltd v Chandan Kumar and Anr. in its order dated 01.03.2017 has made following observations:-

"8. This Court is of the view that in the case of death/injury of employees arising out of and during the course of his employment with a contractor in respect of contracts awarded by the Government and in the event of the failure of the contractor to deposit the same within a period of 30 days, the Government should deposit the compensation amount under section 4A of the Employees Compensation Act and thereafter, deduct the same from amount payable to the contractor. It would be appropriate to issue directions in this regard to all contractors and also incorporate this clause in the future contracts."

In view of the aforesaid order, in the case of death/injury of employees arising out of and during the course of his employment with a contractor in
