



CIRCULAR

Employees Compensation Act, 1923 is an employees' welfare legislation providing for compensation to the employees or his dependents for injury or death arising out of and in the course of employment. It is applicable on 'employers' which are not covered by Employees State Insurance Act, 1948.

In many cases the Government engages employees/executes works/projects through the contractor and these employees are the workers of the Contractors and liability to pay compensation for injury or death of the employees primarily lies with the contractor and in view of section 4A of the Employees Compensation Act it shall be paid as soon as it falls due. If the compensation is not paid within one month from the date it fell due, the Commissioner shall direct payment of interest. Further, section 4A3(b) of the Act empowers the Commissioner to impose penalty upto 50% of the amount after issuing notice and affording opportunity of hearing to the employer.

The Hon'ble High Court in the matter FAO 339/2016, M/s Simplex Infrastructure Ltd v Chandan Kumar and Anr. in its order dated 01.03.2017 has made following observations :-

" 8. This Court is of the view that in the case of death/injury of employees arising out of and during the course of his employment with a contractor in respect of contracts awarded by the Government and in the event of the failure of the contractor to deposit the same within a period of 30 days, the Government should deposit the compensation amount under section 4A of the Employees Compensation Act and thereafter, deduct the same from amount payable to the contractor. It would be appropriate to issue directions in this regard to all contractors and also incorporate this clause in the future contracts."

In view of the aforesaid order, in the case of death/injury of employees arising out of and during the course of his employment with a contractor in

Accordingly, Election Commission's of India has directed to conduct Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls w.r.t. 01.01.2018 as qualifying date, in NCT of Delhi as per schedule given below:

4.	Special Campaign Dates with Booth Level Agents of political parties for receiving claims and objections	29.10.2017 (Sunday) and 05.11.2017(Sunday)
5.	Disposal of Claims and Objections	By 11.12.2017 (Monday)
6.	Updating the database, merging of photographs, updating the Control Tables and preparation and printing of supplementary list	By 26.12.2017 (Tuesday)
7.	Final Publication of Electoral Rolls	08.01.2018 (Monday)

During the period allowed for filing claims and objections i.e. 23.10.2017 to 13.11.2017, any eligible person including those who will be completing 18 years of age on 01.01.2018 can apply for inclusion of their name in the electoral roll in NCT of Delhi. The application for inclusion in electoral roll may be made in Form-6, deletion of an existing entry from the electoral roll in Form-7, correction in existing entry in Form-8 and change of address within same Assembly Constituency in Form-8A. All these Forms can be downloaded from the website of this department [www.ceodelhi.gov.in](http://www.ceodelhi.gov.in). Further, the application in concerned Form may also be made online through [www.ceodelhi.gov.in](http://www.ceodelhi.gov.in) or [www.nvsp.in](http://www.nvsp.in).



respect of contracts awarded by any department/autonomous bodies/PSUs in the event of the failure of the contractor to deposit the same within a period of 30 days, the concerned department/autonomous body/PSU should deposit the compensation amount due under section 4A of the Employees Compensation Act, 1923 with the concerned district Employees' Compensation Commissioner i.e. Jt. Labour Commissioner/ Dy. Labour Commissioner of the district of Labour Department and thereafter, deduct the same from the amount payable to the contractor.

All concerned Principal Employers engaging services of various contractors are requested to issue further necessary directions to all the contractors in this regard and also incorporate this clause in the future contracts.
