
This year we are organising **Folk Song Competition at Central Park, Connaught Place, New Delhi** on **13th December, 2018** at 10.00 a.m.

2. Each student will be given 3-5 minutes to present his/her song.
3. Only three traditional musical instruments will be allowed.
4. No electronic musical instrument will be allowed.
5. The decision of the judges will be final.
6. The students securing 1st, 11nd and 111rd positions will be given cash prize of Rs.1500/-, Rs.1200/- and Rs.1000/- a memento and a certificate respectively.
