Government of India is celebrating the birth anniversary of Dr B R Ambedkar from 14/4/2018 to 5/5/2018 as 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan' with the objective of promoting social harmony. Dr Ambedkar Jayanti, 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 is to be celebrated as 'Samajik Nyay Diwas' (Social Justice Day).

- 2. Commemorative activities such as Public Lectures/ talks by eminent scholars/ academicians, holding of debates, quiz competitions on the theme of Rashtriya Samrasta/ Samajik Nyay amongst students of schools and colleges, organising runs for social justice, felicitations of bright children at Panchayat level need to be undertaken.
- 3. The State Governments should undertake, in a camp mode, outreach programmes for this fortnight, to identify out of school children as well as those without a requisite caste and income certificates.
- 4. Following activities need to be taken up:
  - > Camps to be held on 14/04/2018 onwards, for a fortnight in identified villages for providing caste and income certificates to those Scheduled Caste families who do not have caste and income certificates.
  - > All children from Class. VIII onwards must be enrolled in the school.
  - > 100% enrolment of students must be ensured.
  - ➤ Eligible Scheduled Caste students based on income criteria under appropriate scheme must also be enrolled for appropriate scholarships Pre Matric Scholarship and Post Matric Sholarship.
- 5. This activity needs to be undertaken on a Mission Mode commencing from 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. The progress will be monitored on an MIS whose details will be made available shortly.
