- vii. Giving an identity to the City --- based on its main Economic Activity, such as Local Culsine, Health, Education, Arts and Craft, Culture, Sports Goods, Furniture, Hosiery, Textile, Dairy, etc.
- viii. Applying Smart Solutions to Infrastructure and Services In Area-Based Development in order to make them better. For example, Making Areas less Vuinerable to Disasters, using fewer resources, and providing cheaper services.

#### Preamble

Proper planning of limited available resources is difficult but not impossible. This is Evident from the Success behind Singapore's Beautiful Skyline.
