? How to Register?

Individuals

Anyone can register through an email and phone number. A verification email is sent to the user and after verification, the user is registered as either an innovator or an administrator depending on whether the email id is a gov.in/nic.in email.

Administrators

Administrators to register with gov.in or nic.in email ID to be able to submit needs.

Organisations

Organisations can register either as an individual user or collaborate with LINK. Those organisations whose members may also register as individual innovators are suggested to register as a collaboration. For example, e-cell, IIT Bombay may be collaborating with LINK but a startup in e-cell network may just register as an individual user.

Roles and Responsibilities of Cadre Ambassadors

The duties of the Cadre Ambassadors will be as below:

1. Presentation regarding LINK at various forums. Mentioning during
 - Call on
 - Local workshop, seminars and other events
 - Spreading awareness about LINK in other services - IPS, IFS, State services.
 - Ensuring that respective cadre association for the services are onboard the platform
 - Coordinate with entities within each state who can contribute to LINK - entrepreneurship bodies, state innovation cell, research groups, NGOs etc.
 - Identify experts, influencers within services as well as outside the government who can help in finding or closing unmet needs in various sectors like education, health etc.

The ambassadors will ensure that more and more needs come through the platform from the districts which can then be worked upon. Every year, the Officer Trainees of the current batch will be designated as Cadre Ambassadors for each cadre based on criteria to be devised by the Innovation Club which is the dedicated team comprising of Officer Trainees of 2019 batch to look after the work of LINK and other related activities.
