Alternatively, the person should have obtained at least two patents or contributed to the increased productivity in the place of work recognized at state or national level or elected as a Fellow of any of the national academies. However, the procedure of providing equivalence shall be devised by concerned affiliating University.

Note 3: Experience at Diploma level Polytechnic shall be considered equivalent to experience in the degree level Institutions at appropriate level, as applicable provided, scale of pay, qualifications, experience and research contribution are same for the post under consideration as per the present notification.

Note 4: If a class/division is not awarded, a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent to 1st class/division. If a Grade point system is adopted, the CGPA will be converted to equivalent marks as below:
