CIRCULAR

Sub:- National Mass Deworming Programme on 8th February 2019 followed by MOP up Day (MUD) for left out children on 14th February 2019.

The first phase of National Deworming Programme was successfully implemented in August, 2018. As per direction of Child Health Division, MoHFW, Govt. of India, two phases of De-worming programme shall be executed in Delhi each year.

It has been planned to implement the 1st phase of School based Biannual National Mass De-worming programme in Delhi on 8th February 2019 followed by MOP up Day (MUD) for left out children on 14th February 2019.

All school going children from Nursery to class XII, will be administered a single dose of chewable Tab. "**Albendazole**", even small children, is a national policy.

Dose of Tablet Albendazole for National Mass Deworming Day is as follows:-

1 to 2 years - 200 mg i.e. half tablet of Albendazole.

More than 2 years - 400 mg i.e. 1 tablet of Albendazole.

Tablet Albendazole is to be **dissolved and administered** to all children below 6 years of age.

All schools have to nominate a Nodal Teacher for execution of the programme. Nodal Teacher will impart training to class teachers on administration of Albendazole.

Albendazole tablet is as such a safe drug, however in very rare cases children with mild adverse event (pain abdomen, nausea vomiting etc.) may require medical intervention. Health & FW Department has created a three tier Emergency Response System on National Deworming Day (NDD) & MOP up Day (MUD) as under (i) one ANM/PHNO over 4-5 schools (ii) one MO at each Zone of Education Department (iii) One District MOI/C at District Level (iv) Control Room at SHS (HQ).


