- All papers so received will undergo a blind review process and will be evaluated on different parameters such as originality, relevance, applicability and contribution to findings etc.
- Only a soft copy of full paper is required to be submitted through email (mentioned below).
- All related correspondence will be addressed to the first author.
- A limited number of participants shall be registered, subject to acceptance of paper.
- No Registration Fee for participation but prior registration is compulsory.
- Submission of filled copy right form is compulsory.

- 10. References (must be in conformity with the APA Style guidelines).
- 11. Appendices (if any)- images, graphs & tools used in the study should form part of appendices not the main paper.
