OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Revision of Tates of Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA) in Health Service Officersrespect Central recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission.

The Seventh Central Pay Commission has recommended that Non Practicing Allowance (NPA) should be paid at the rate of 20 percent of Basic Pay, subject to the condition that Basic Pay + NPA should not exceed the average of Apex Level and the level of Cabinet Secretary. Consequent upon acceptance of recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission by the Government, the President is pleased to decide that the NPA shall now be paid at the rate of 20% of the basic pay in the revised pay structure in vogue based on the recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission, as contained in the CCS (RP) Rules, 2016, subject to the condition that the sum of basic pay and NPA does not exceed Rs. 2,37,500 (Rupees two lakh thirty seven thousand and five hundred only). The following conditions shall regulate the grant of NPA under these orders:

- (i) The term "basic pay' in the revised pay structure shall mean "basic pay" as defined in Rule 3(x) of CCS (RP) Rules, 2016, i.e., "basic pay" in revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed Level in the Pay Matrix.
- (ii) The NPA shall continue to be treated as pay for the purpose of computation of Dearness Allowance and other allowance, except those allowances in respect of which the applicable orders provide otherwise, including calculation of retirement benefits. Dearness Allowance under these orders shall mean dearness allowance as sanctioned by the Central Government from time to time in the 7th Pay Commission-related pay structure.
- (iii) NPA shall continue to be restricted to those medical posts for which medical qualifications recognised under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or under the Dentist Act, 1948 have been prescribed as an essential qualification. The following conditions shall also be fulfilled as hitherto:-
 - (a) The post is a clinical one.
 - (b) The post is a whole time post.
 - (c) There is ample scope for private practice, and
 - (d) It is necessary to prohibit private practice in public interest.

Recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission-Revision of rates of Annual Allowance in respect of Central Health Service Officers.

After The amider signed is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the Seventh Central Pay Commission has recommended to raise Annual Allowance by 50 percent. The amount will further rise by 25 percent each time DA rises by 50 percent. Consequent upon acceptance of recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission by the Government, the President is pleased to decide that hereafter the officers of Teaching, Non-Teaching, Public Health sub-cadres and General Duty Medical Officers having PG qualification recognized under Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 will be granted Annual Allowance at the rate of Rs. 2250/- p.m. (Rupees Two Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty per month). The General Duty Medical Officers who do not possess any Post Graduate qualification or who may possess unrecognized PG qualification will be granted Annual Allowance at the rate of Rs. 1350/- p.m. (Rupees One Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty per month). These revised rates of Annual Allowance will be subject to the following condition:-

'At the end of financial year, each Specialist/General Duty Medical Officer will be required to furnish a certificate to the effect that the amount of Annual Allowance has been utilized for the purpose it was drawn. In the case of retirement/resignation before the end of the financial year, such a certificate will be furnished at the time of such retirement/resignation.'

- The rates of these allowances will be increased by 25 % each time the Dearness Allowance payable on revised pay scale rises by 50 %.
- 3. This order will take effect from 01.07.2017.

This issues with the concurrence of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide its I.D No.300347034/2017 (F.No. 19062/01/2017-E.IV) dated 17.08.2017.

 - (ii) OM dated 30.08.2017 for recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission-Revision of rates of Annual Allowance in respect of Central Health Service Officers. (CD 112467482)
- The Admn. Deptt. has requested to endorse the aforesaid OMs for the benefit of various Non Teaching Specialist and General Duty Medical Officer working in DHS cadre which were issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of India.
- The matter was earlier examined in Finance Department and Admn. Deptt. was requested to add the relevant files wherein approval of Finance Department was obtained.
- The Admn. Deptt. vide their preceding notes mentioned that several efforts were made to locate these files or orders wherein such orders were implemented in H&FW Department, however the same is not traceable. It is further mentioned that as per Rule 14 (1) of DHS (Allopathy) Rules, 2009, the condition of service of members of DHS shall be mutatis & mutandis and subject to any special order issued by Govt. in respect of service, be the same as those applicable to the officers of Central Civil Services in general (page 3/C).
- In this regard, it is submitted that Finance Department endorsed the OM dated 07.07.2017 (page 38-40/C) issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India regarding revision of rates of Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA) in respect of medical posts other than the posts included in the Central Health Services-recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission. In the aforesaid OM, Ministry of Finance advised the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of AYUSH to issue similar orders in respect of medical posts under CHS and the posts under AYUSH respectively. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India has issued OM dated 21.12.2017 for CHS cadre.
- In view of above, if agreed, FD may like to convey no objection for endorsing the OM dated 21.12.2017 & 30.08.2017 for the benefit of Non Teaching Specialists and General Duty Medical Officers working in DHS cadre.
